

## CAN I SCHEDULE A GROUP?

If your club or organization serves seniors and people with disabilities and you would like to schedule a group trip, arrangements can be made by writing a letter at least four weeks in advance to the following address:

Prepare your request on a club letterhead and include the date of the trip, number of participants, start and end time, rain date, contact person's name, telephone number, pick up and destination point, number of people using mobility devices and any other pertinent information necessary for transportation.

Once the request is approved, you will receive a phone call within approximately one week to confirm and update the information.

## WHAT IS PARA-TRANSIT?

Passaic County Para-Transit is a curb to curb transportation service for senior citizens and people with disabilities residing in Passaic County. Seniors are eligible at 60 years of age.

You may call Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 am to 4:00 pm to reserve a trip. Trips may be one-way, round trip or recurring trips. All rides are scheduled on a first come first served basis, depending on availability. Preferably within 3 to 8 days advance notice. For after hours or weekend trips call the contact person for your scheduled trip for any information.

Lift equipped vans are available to accommodate people using a mobility device

Transportation to the Veteran's Hospital in East Orange is available every Monday and Tuesday by county Paratransit and service provided on Wednesdays by Clifton and Thursdays by Paterson. This service is funded by the Board of Chosen Freeholders, New Jersey Transit, the Federal Transit Administration, New Jersey Casino Tax Revenue and the Passaic County Department of Senior Services, Disability & Veterans Affairs. Title VI discrimination complaint forms are available.
