

Daily COVID-19 Update Summary, Passaic County, NJ

Saturday March 21, 2020

As of 11am today, Passaic County has **18 new positive presumptive** cases of COVID-19.

This brings the **total** for Passaic County to **79 positive presumptive** cases.

In addition, we had our **first fatality: an 86-year old male from Passaic City.**

Summary: 2 hospitalized, exposures unknown, 2 in critical condition, and 3 in stable condition.
