TOTOWA SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS AND THE PATERSON MUNICIPAL  
ELECTION**

**Paterson, NJ** - Passaic County Clerk, Danielle Ireland-Imhof, has important elections information to share with voters in the City of Passaic, the Borough of Totowa and the City of Paterson.

In light of the ongoing COVID-19 public health crisis, Governor Murphy mandated that all New Jersey counties with April School Board elections and May Municipal elections will hold their elections on May 12, 2020 and those elections will take place only with vote-by-mail ballots. Registered voters will automatically receive a vote-by-mail ballot for the upcoming elections. Along with your ballot you will receive instructions for proper completion and a postage paid envelope for you to return your ballot. Ballots must be postmarked by May 12 and received by the Passaic County Board of Elections within 48 hours.
