CLERK DANIELLE IRELAND-IMHOF ADVISES THE APRIL SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS AND THE SPECIAL SCHOOL BOARD ELECTION WILL BE CONDUCTED IN-PERSON

PATERSON, NJ – Passaic County Clerk, Danielle Ireland-Imhof, advises the residents of the City of Clifton, City of Passaic, and the Borough of Totowa, that New Jersey Governor Philip Murphy signed Executive Order No. 223, stating the School Board Elections and the Special School Board Election, being held on April 20, 2021, will be conducted in-person, at polling locations with the use of voting machines.

Registered voters that cannot, or wish not to, go to the polls on Election Day may request a vote-by-mail (VBM) ballot from the County Clerk's Office. The County Clerk's Office, located at 401 Grand Street, Room 130, Paterson, New Jersey 07505, will be open Monday, April 12 through Friday, April 16, 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.; Saturday, April 17, 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.; and Monday, April 19, 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. for in-person ballot requests.
