PATERSON, NJ – Passaic County Clerk, Danielle Ireland-Imhof, advises the residents of the City of Passaic that New Jersey Governor Philip Murphy stated during the February 8, 2021 Public Address, the May Municipal Election, being held on May 11, 2021, will be conducted in-person, at polling locations with the use of voting machines.

Registered voters that cannot, or wish not to, go to the polls on Election Day may request a vote-by-mail (VBM) ballot from the County Clerk's Office.
