Passaic County Paratransit NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Passaic County Board of County Commissioners and the Division of Paratransit will conduct a public hearing on transportation funding for Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons. The County is applying to New Jersey Transit, Inc. for funds under the Senior Citizen and Disabled Resident Transportation Assistance Act for Fiscal Year 2026.
