

ATTENTION REGISTERED VOTERS OF PASSAIC COUNTY

**PARTY DECLARATION DEADLINE IS APRIL 8th, 2026, FOR THE JUNE 2nd, 2026
PRIMARY ELECTION**

The Election law in New Jersey requires certain voters, who intend to vote in the June 2nd, 2026 PRIMARY ELECTION, to file a Party Declaration Form by April 8th, 2026 (55 days before the June 2nd, 2026, Primary Election)

VOTERS WHO MUST FILE:

- A. Voters who intend to vote in a political party **OTHER** than their **LAST** Primary vote.
- B. Voters who wish to vote in the Primary Election who are affiliated with a political party other than the Democratic or Republican Party.
- C. Unaffiliated Vote-By-Mail Voters who wish to receive a ballot.

VOTERS WHO NEED NOT FILE:

- A. Voters who shall vote in the same political party as their **last** Primary vote.
- B. All registered voters who are currently Unaffiliated and do not wish to receive a vote-by mail ballot.

VOTERS WHO SEND IN AFFILIATION REQUESTS AFTER THE DEADLINE:

If when submitting a voter registration form for any reason, a registrant declares thereon his or her political party affiliation and in so doing declares affiliation with a political party other than the political party with which the person was affiliated previously, the registrant shall be **INELIGIBLE to vote** in the next succeeding primary election unless he or she has made the declaration of affiliation with the political party specified in the latest voter registration form no later than the 55th day preceding such primary election. *Title 19:31-13-2.*

**LAST DAY TO FILE DECLARATION OF PARTY FOR THE June 2nd, 2026 PRIMARY IS
April 8th, 2026**

A voter who is listed to receive mail-in ballots for all future elections, pursuant to the provisions of section 3 of P.L.2009, c.79 (C.19:63-3) or section 14 of P.L.2018, c.72 (C.19:63-3.1), and who is not affiliated with any political party shall not receive a mail-in ballot for a primary election. Such unaffiliated mail-in voters shall receive a political party affiliation declaration form and information concerning how to affiliate with a political party and how to vote in person at a polling place on the day of a primary election.

You may obtain Political Party Affiliation Declaration forms from the office of the Commissioner of Registration at the following address, 501 River Street, Paterson, N.J. 07524, or from your Municipal Clerk's office, either in person, by writing, or by phone. You may also be able to obtain such form at the Passaic County Board of Elections Office or the Passaic County Clerk's Office, both located at 401 Grand Street, Paterson, N.J. 07524.
