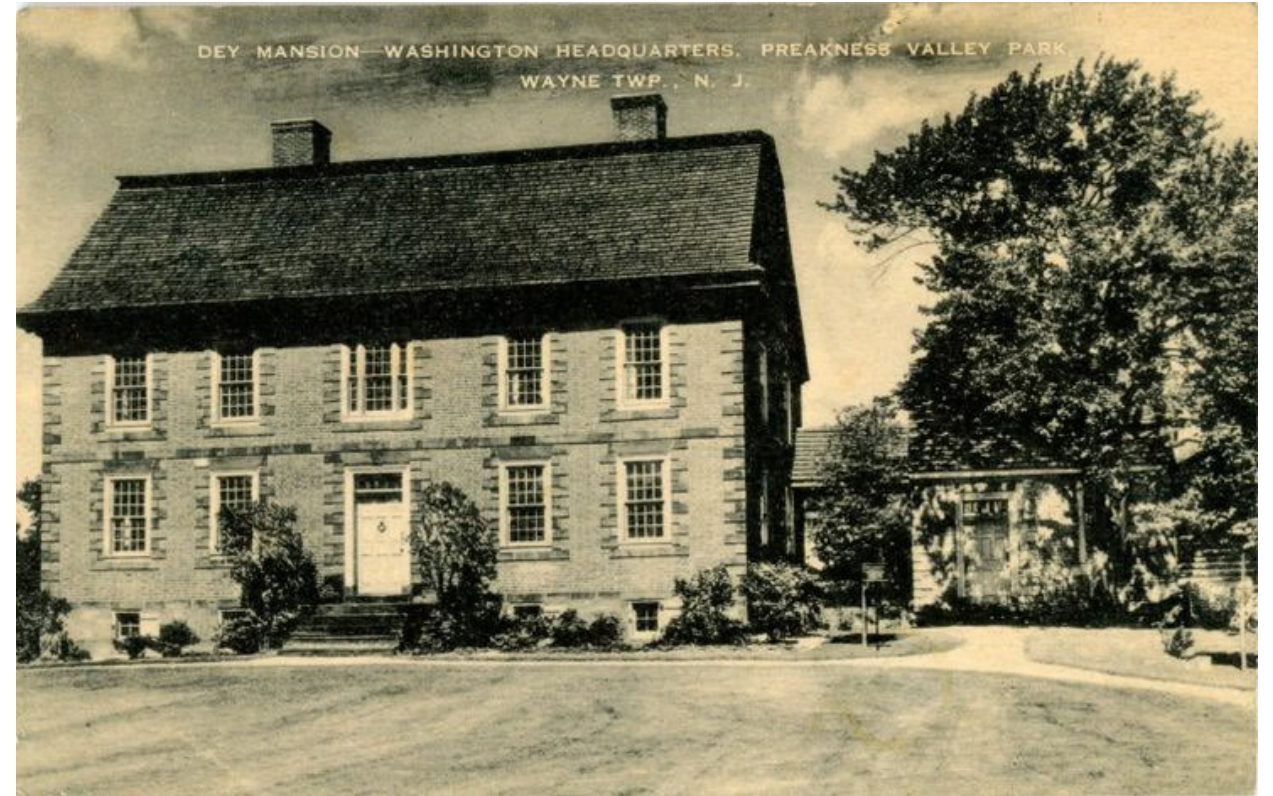

HISTORY

- Built by Colonel Theunis and Hester Dey in c.1770s
- Theunis Dey was a representative in the State Council for Bergen County and charter trustee of Queens College (Rutgers University)
- General George Washington's Headquarters during July, October, and November of 1780
- Washington directed the attack on Bull's Ferry while at the mansion
- Olmsted designed gardens incrementally planted 1937-1941
- Acquired by Passaic County in 1930, opened in 1934 as a museum
- Added to National Register in 1970

- 2025 – Kitchen Garden

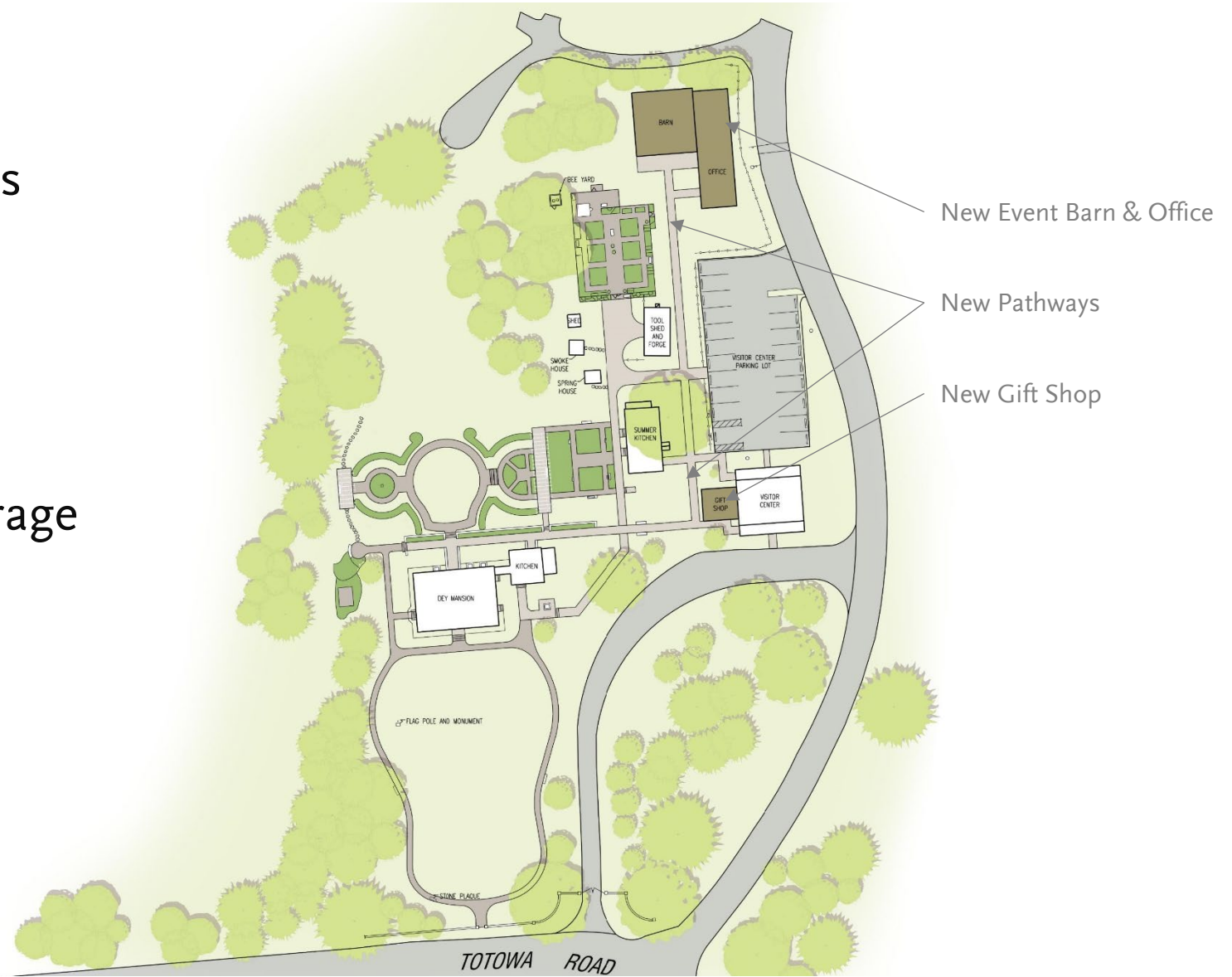


North Façade and Olmsted Gardens

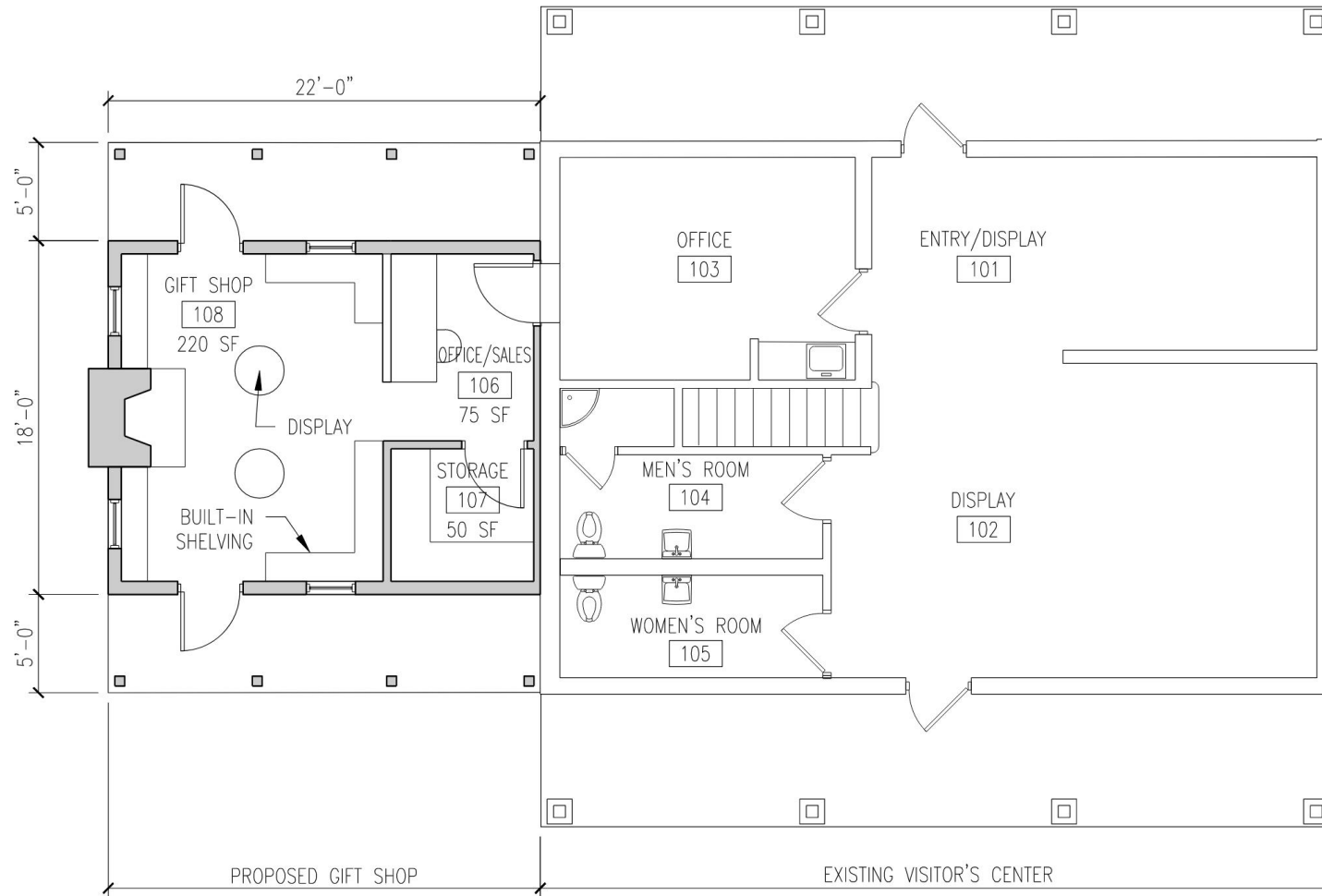

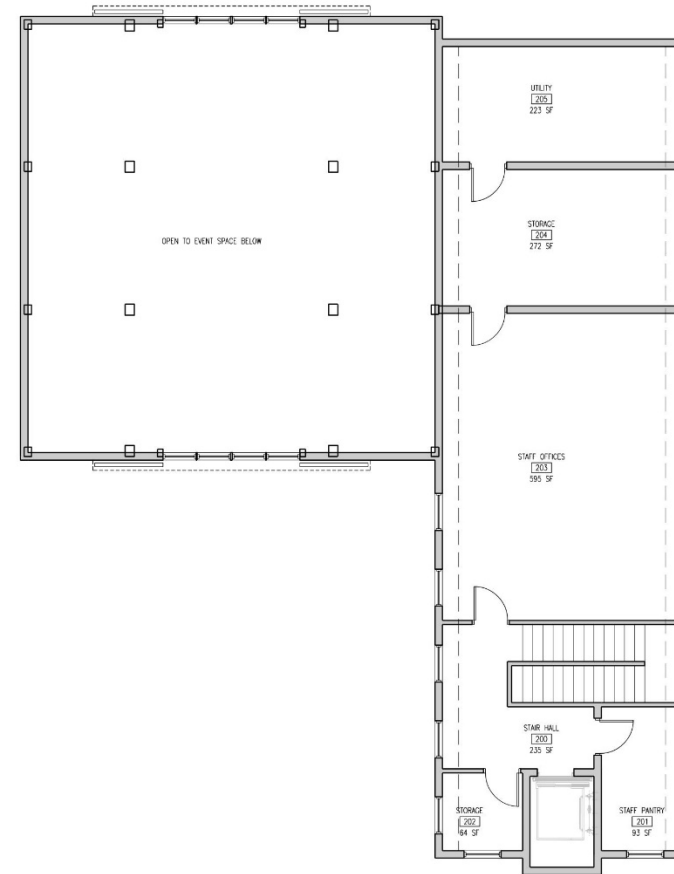
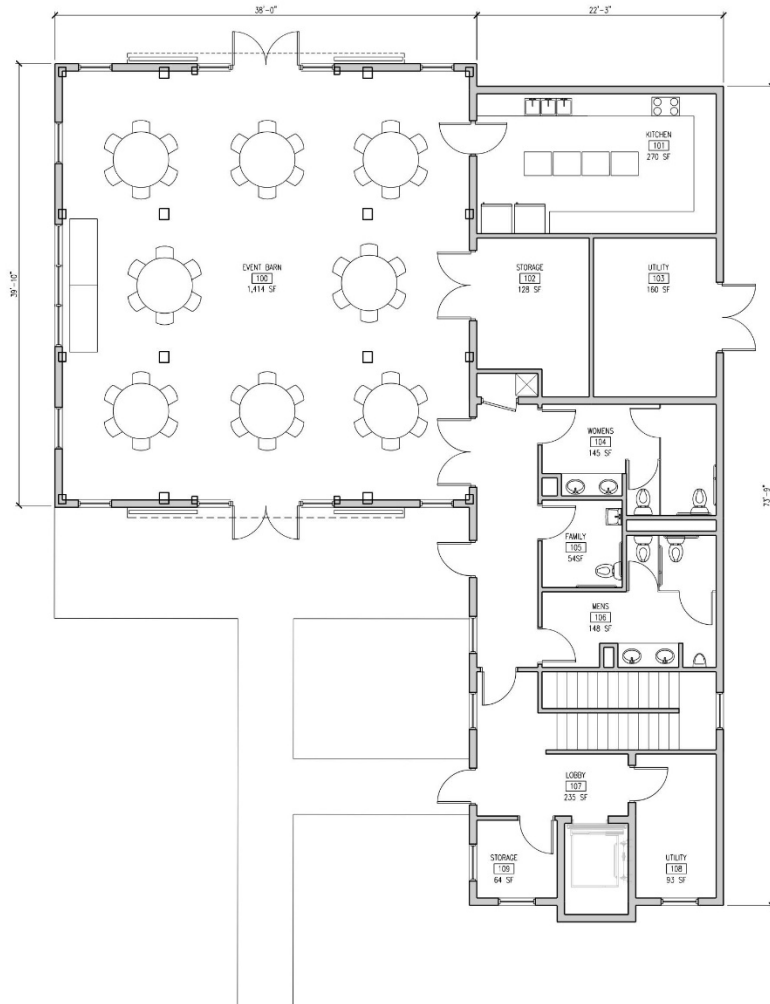
